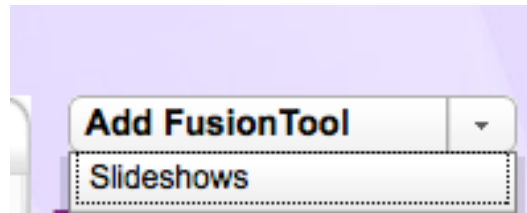


Adding a Slideshow to your Page

You must be logged into a School Fusion page of which you are an Administrator (e.g. your classroom page.)

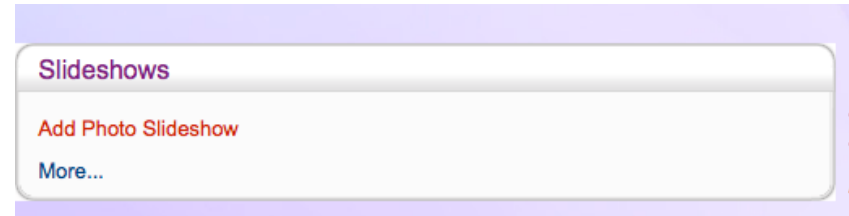
- If you do not have the “fusion tool” slideshows on your page, you will want to activate that tool:



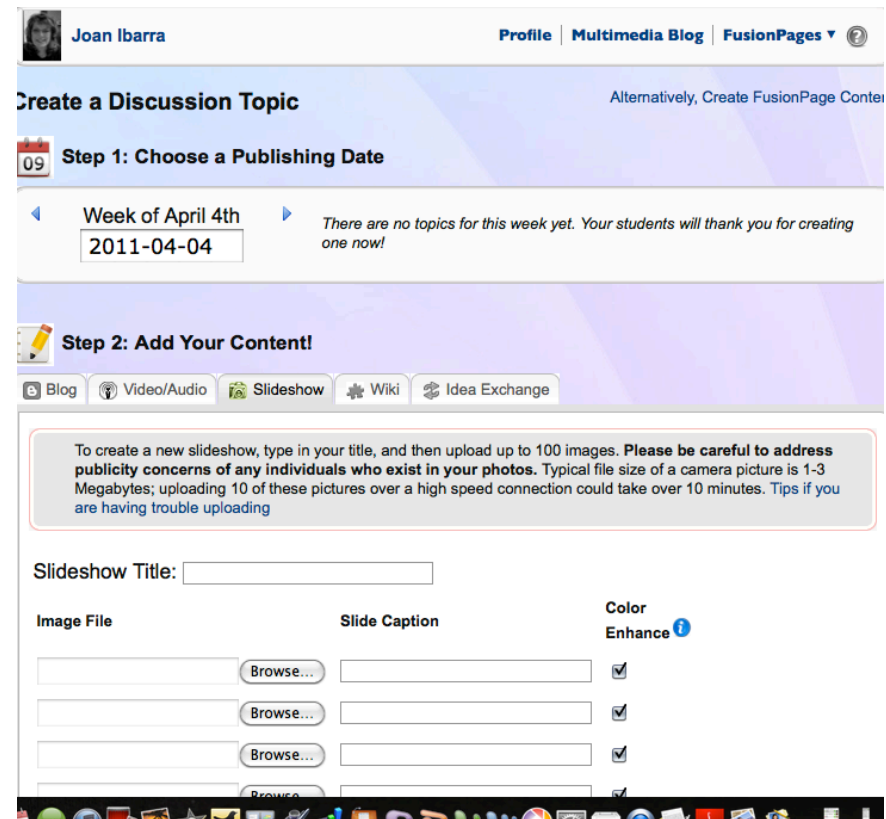
- When it is activated you will have a “slideshow” box on your page:



- Click “add photo slideshow”




- This box will show up



- Name your slide show: Slideshow Title:

- Browse to your images and add them. You may add a caption if you wish:

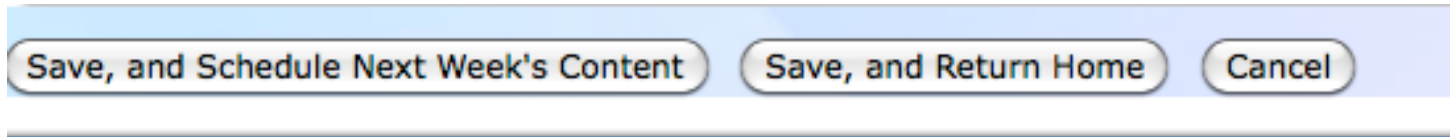

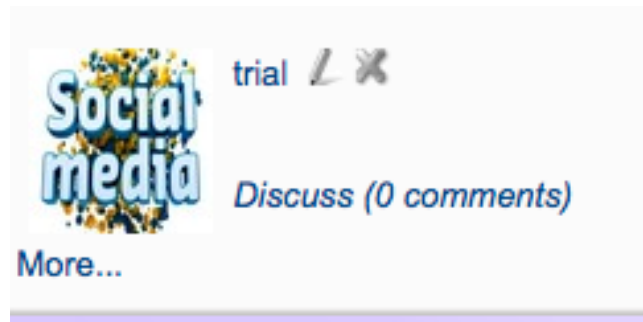

- After saving, your slideshow will show up in the slideshow box on your page:



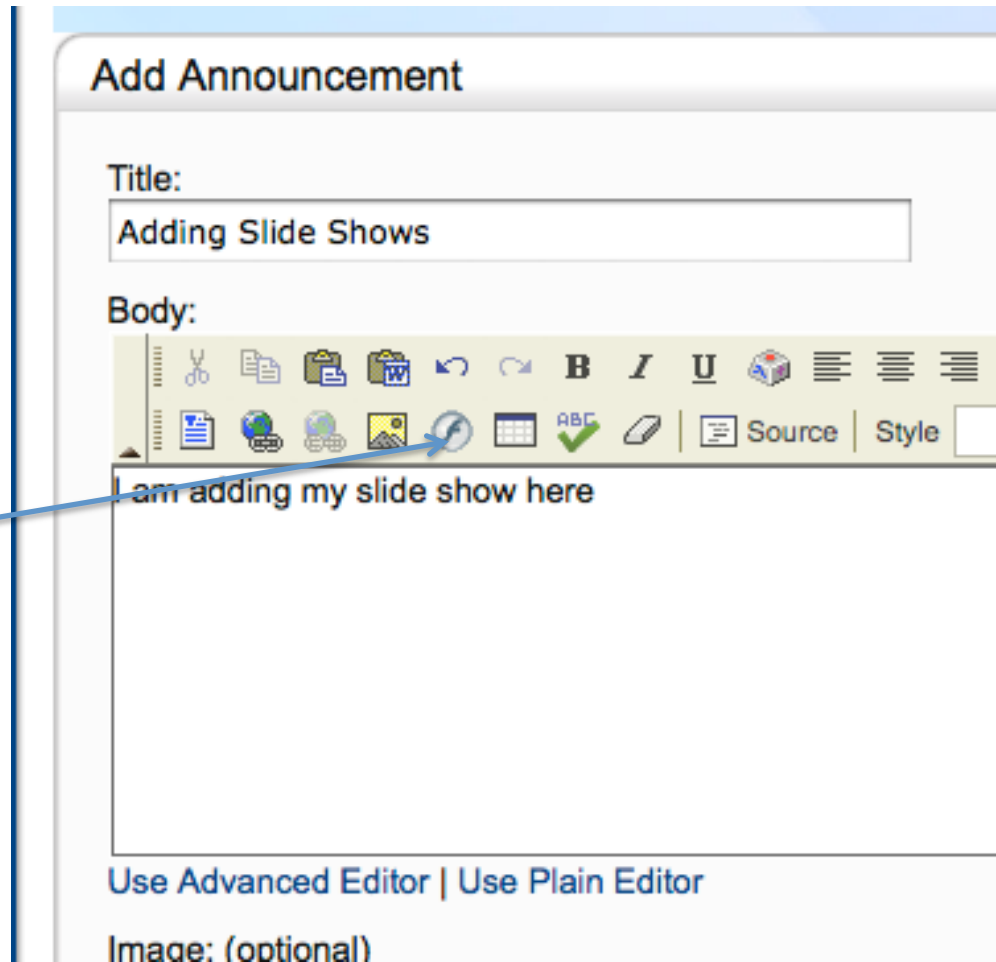
Sharing Slideshows in Announcements

- You can also share a slideshow within an announcement (or webpage) on your fusion page. Within your announcement, when you come to the place you want to add the slide show, you click the flash button and add the slide show:

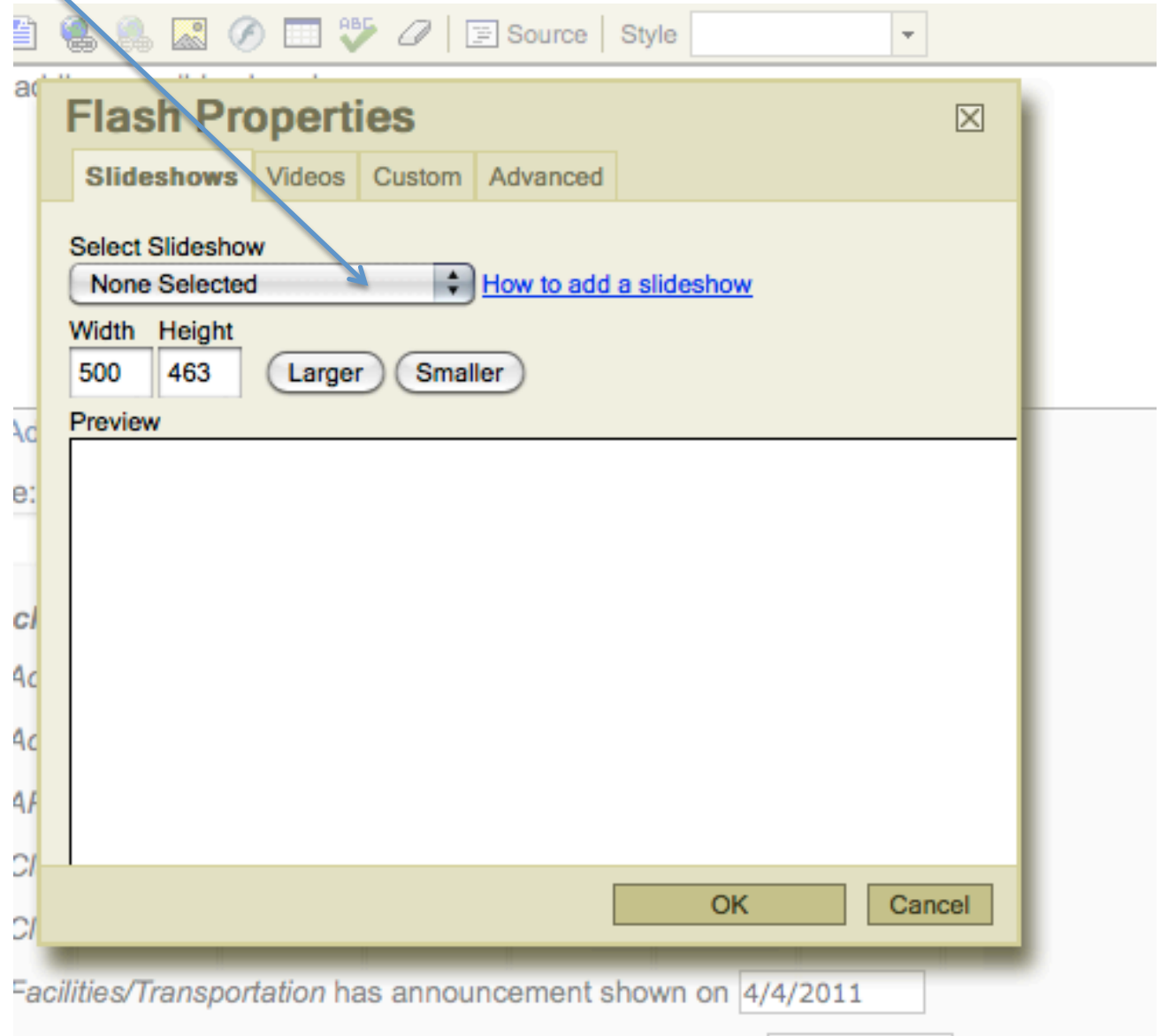


- I am going to add a slide show within my announcement where I have stopped typing:

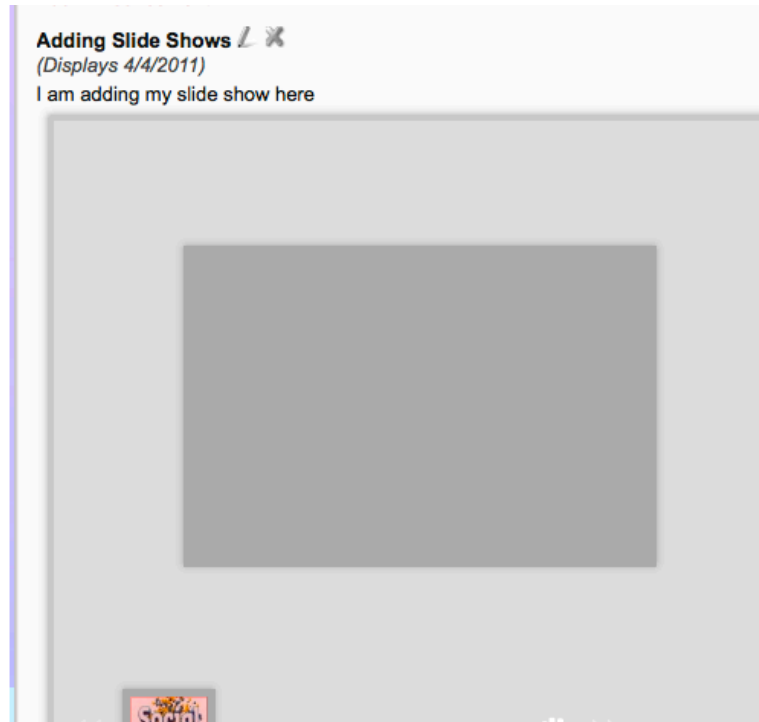
- See the flash button



- You will choose your slideshow from the drop down menu:



- When you add your slide show, it will then show up within your document:



- After you have chosen your slide show, you can continue with your article. (Or you can come back and insert your slideshow within your article when it is complete). Once done, be sure and choose which of your fusion pages you would like to share this announcement on.

- Be sure and click “save”.



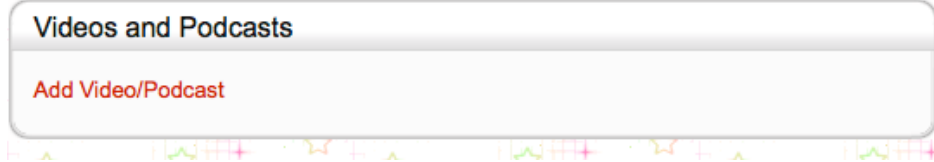
Videos

- To add a video to your school fusion page you must have the fusion tool “videos and podcasts” on your fusion page:

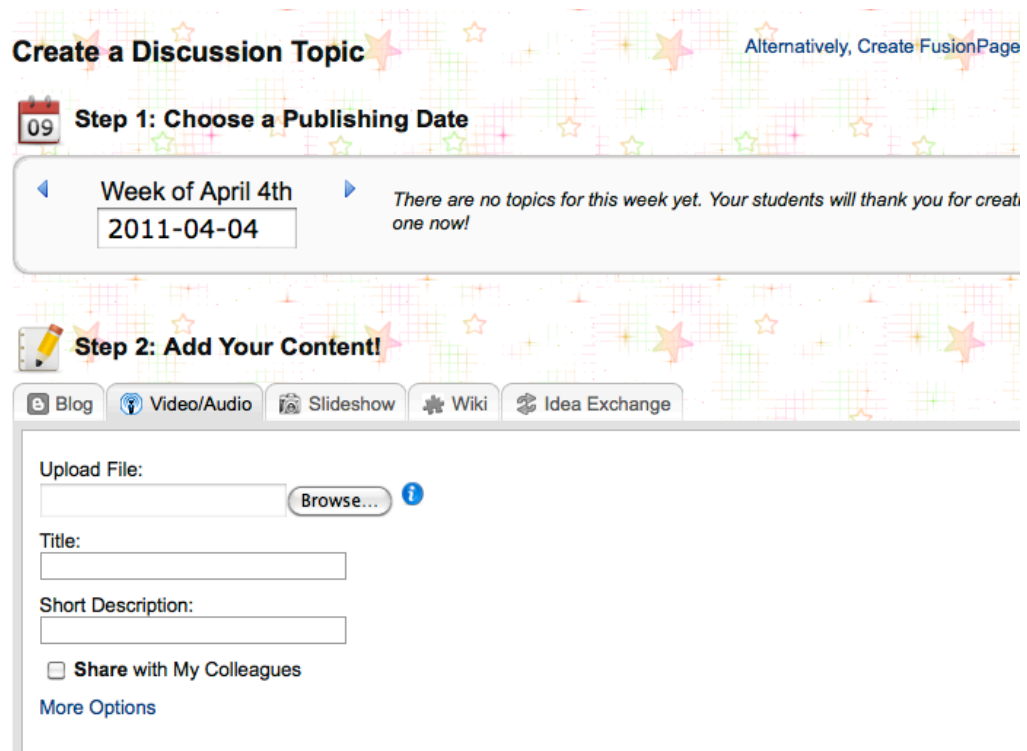


- Add it the same way that we added Photo Slideshows.

- Click on Add Video:



- This box arrives the same way as it did for Photo Slideshows:



- Click on the “videos/podcasts” tab to upload your saved video/movie.
- Give it a title, add to whichever fusion pages you want it on, and click “save”.

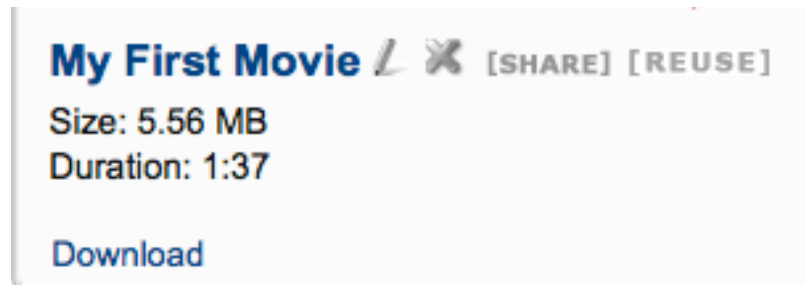
